

# YAVAPAI COUNTY ANIMAL CONTROL

1. If you already have a YCSO dog license/ I.D. tag, this numbered tag is now a permanent ID for your dog. If you do not have a tag or have lost the old tag, we will issue a new one.
2. Your dog must have a current rabies vaccination that was administered by a licensed veterinarian.
3. Pay the registration/license fee from 1-3 years either online, in person or by mail.

**IN PERSON:** Bring Rabies certificate and any previous County dog license number and cash or check to Yavapai Humane Society/Wellness Center (Prescott), Verde Valley Humane Society OR Yavapai County Sheriff Offices: Prescott, Mayer, Williamson Valley, Camp Verde or Bagdad.

**BY MAIL:** Send your name, address, phone numbers, email address, dog information and previous tag number, Rabies certificate and check or money order to Yavapai County Sheriff. Mail to YCSO Animal Control, 255 E. Gurley, Prescott, AZ 86301.
